85%

of health professionals say
that addiction to opioids is a
major problem in the country



**Using non-opioid options to
manage pain is an effective solution**

88%

agree that increasing access to
non-opioid solutions would be
effective in helping providers
address the U.S. opioid epidemic

**Healthcare professionals
overwhelmingly support
non-opioid options for pain...**

96%

of clinicians support the
utilization of non-opioid
approaches to pain
management

More than 3 out of 4 agree
that non-opioid options are better for
patients' physical and mental health

**But, access to
non-opioid options
remain a challenge**

85%

of clinicians agree that
they need more access to
non-opioid approaches

More than 3 out 4 say
that a lack of insurance coverage of
non-opioid options contributes to the high
rate of opioid addiction in the U.S.
