STATE FACTS



1,187 DEATHS were attributed to a drug overdose between

June 2020 and 2021.1



A 29% INCREASE

in overdose deaths was reported between June 2019 and 2021.²

35.5 OPIOID PRESCRIPTIONS

were written for every 100 persons in Minnesota in 2018.³

3.75 MILLION

or 9.2% of patients go on to long-term opioid use after a low-risk surgery (e.g. inguinal hernia repair, knee arthroscopy.) ⁵

80 PILLS

is the average amount of opioids that patients receive after orthopedic surgery whether they need them or not.6



9.7 MILLION

people misused prescription pain relievers in 2019.7

OVER 101,000 DEATHS

from a drug-related overdose were reported in one year's time ending in June 2021. This is the highest number of overdose deaths ever recorded in a 12-month period.⁸

OVER 76,000 PEOPLE

died of an opioid overdose between June 2020 and 2021 — 49% more people than the estimated number of motor-vehicle fatalities in 2021.9,10
