Do You Know Your Non-Opioid Pain Treatment Options?

Congress passed the Non-Opioids Prevent Addiction in the Nation ('NOPAIN') Act in December 2022. Now in effect, the NOPAIN Act prevents opioid addiction by allowing for separate reimbursement for non-opioid therapies for acute pain under Medicare.

THE OPIOID CRISIS IN AMERICA



150 Americans died every day from an opioid-related drug overdose in 2024.¹



As many as **90 percent of surgical patients** in the U.S. receive an opioid prescription.²



Between **6 to 20 percent of surgical patients** exposed to opioids will initiate long-term use.^{3,4}



The Joint Economic Committee estimates that the U.S. spends approximately **\$1.5 trillion** annually to address the opioid epidemic.⁵
